# SPAY/NEUTER

## SPAY/NEUTER IS PART OF A COMPASSIONATE CARE PLAN FOR CATS!

The domestication of companion animals removed them from the “natural order” and placed responsibility for their care with humans. Spay or Neuter surgery is a part of normal routine care for cats. It is generally safe to consider kittens as young as eight weeks old to be spayed or neutered. It is advised to have this surgery performed before your cat reached five months of age, which is when cats reach sexual maturity.
